- Every yacht to have a keel(s), engine and be capable of reefing.
- Application for entry shall be made on the Eddystone Charity Sailing Pursuit Entry Form together with the entry fee.
- Entry applications will not be accepted by the RWYC after 14th July
- Every yacht shall monitor VHF Channel 72 throughout the event.
- Every yacht shall fly the event flag from the back stay (or suitable position aft) and display its Entry Number using the provided sign.
- The RWYC reserves the right to place an entrant into a "Restricted" category. Depending upon conditions on the day, entrants placed in the "Restricted" category may not be allowed to partake in the event. See Sailing Instructions.

Legal Liability

- By signing this Entry Form, participants accept that they are responsible for themselves, their crew and their boats, whether afloat or ashore.
- Nothing done by the organisers (i.e. the Club, Event Management Team, Patrol Craft and anyone helping to run the event) will relieve participants of their responsibilities.
